Sincere thanks to the society for inviting me to judge and to the exhibitors for their entry. I enjoyed my day very much.

Class 1 Minor Puppy Dog – 1. Clutterbucks Kutani Taboo, 8 month old gold and white, nicely balanced boy with alert stance. Pleasant head with good mouth and excellent broad dentition, Nice reach of neck which flowed to well set shoulders. Confident on the move and tail set held well. BPD AND BPIS 2. Taylor and Johnson's Khinjan Parti Time, 6 month gold and white raw youngster. Nice dark eye and expression, broad chest and nice strong rear. Tail set needed to settle. A little unsteady on the move but warmed as the class progressed

Class 2. Puppy Dog – 1. Beddoe's Aspera Snow Storm, mature gold and white who had a lovely head and dark eye. Good strong bone, very balanced. He moved with assuredness and drive, maintaining level top line. Much to like about this puppy, unlucky to meet MPD in challenge. 2. Watts' Timazinti Britskii at Kenida, mature in coat, nicely proportioned and although different balance to 1, sound in quality. Moved confidently using strong rear. Just preferred the head of the winner.

Class 4. Yearling Dog - 1. Cain's Sandauri Show Stopper for Kutani, 16 month old who exudes quality. The most gentle of heads, lovely dark eye and the length of muzzle. Excellent dentition. Sound boy with good bone and well placed shoulders. He moved with ease using good drive from the front and rear. Such an appealing dog with a super profile and coat. I was delighted to award him BD and BIS. 2. Haigh's Marbledale Jenson Button, another mature boy in excellent gold coat of good texture. Pleasant head with dark eye. Good strong bone. Just a little uneasy on the table but moved confidently round the ring.

Class 7. Special Beginner Dog - Haigh's Marbledale Jenson Button

Class 8 Post graduate dog - 1. Harmers Remrah Rave On JW. Super young man who I am sure will progress well. Sound dog with good bone and fronts. Nice reach of neck, well laid shoulders and moves freely. Lovely head with excellent dentition. Coat texture good as it matures. 2 Hicks Kelankin Billy Wizz, different type to 1, very mature in black coat. Pleasant head and balanced in profile. Moved confidently, preferred the fronts on the winner.

Class 10. Open Dog -1. Hall's Shenedene Don Carlos, beautifully presented gold boy. Good head proportions with a lovely dark eye. Broad dentition and good chin. Mature body, nicely balanced throughout and moved with drive RBD. 2. Roberts Ch. Marbledale Perfection, mature cream boy made of good bone and substance. Correct skull shape, dark eye and pigment. Jaunty on the move

Class 12. Minor Puppy Bitch – 1. Roberts' Marbledale One to Pick. Lovely baby in good cream coat, well balanced through out. Feminine head with a lovely expression and dark well shaped eye and excellent pigment.. Nice broad mouth with full dentition. Moved well, just faded a little at the challenge with the puppy dog. BPB, RBPIS

Class 13 Puppy Bitch – 1. Lawsons' Modarra Coco Chanel. Very feminine head, good length of muzzle, bite and pigment. Nice reach of neck. Good front. She was a little unsteady on the move but settled as the class progressed.

Class 14 – Scarll's Timazinti Kienke. 1. Lovely gold and white with a feminine head, that dark eye expressing so much. Nice length of muzzle and good broad dentition. Good front and level top line. Loved her balance and free confident movement around the ring. BB and RBIS. 2. Holgates' Gemtun Beauty, this young lady was a little out of coat at this stage of development. Good pigment and a nice dark eye. She does lack a little substance about her. Full dentition present but would have liked a broader jaw. On the move showed great confidence, making good use of the ring.

Class 23 – 1. Roberts Marbledale One to Pick. 2. Holgates' Gemtun Beauty

Class 17 – 1. Holgates Moonlight Truffles – Such a sweet feminine head, nice dark eye and good dentition. Coat in that changing stage but developing with the correct texture. A little wide at the front and back gait, lacked a little confidence on the move. Nice tail set.

Class 19. - 1. Halls' Shenadene Hot Gossip - Very balanced young lady in lovely gold coat. Held her head well and had a lovely tailset. Good shoulders and well constructed. Strong pigment and nice dark eye.. Moved well with purpose to win the class but faded a little in the bitch challenge. 2. Taylor & Johnsons Kutani Electra at Chazmeen. Very good head proportions and dark pigment. Liked her overall balance and she has good bone. Positive on the move

Class 20 – Limit bitch 1. Crook's Charjilliam Sheer Simplicity 6 year old in excellent quality coat. Well conditioned with good muscle tone. Lovely head with a dark eye and good muzzle. Moved with ease. 2. Thompsons' Chancinn Kiss This at Toynbee JW. Well balanced bitch, good body. Lovely expression and good pigment. Nice fronts. Just lacked a little energy on the move.

Class 21 – Open bitch 1. Scarll and Sykes' Timazinti Dream Girl. Another quality specimen from this kennel. Great balance throughout. Feminine head, excellent bite and dark lip. Nice sweep of neck to well laid shoulders. Moved around the ring with ease RBB. 2. Seward & Poole's Marnbri Glint of Gloria to Domensa. Lovely mature gold bitch, feminine head, nice reach of stop and good dentition. Shoulders well placed and a good spring of rib.
